## 48th ExCo Meeting, Klagenfurt, Austria

### Including Task meetings and site visit to pumped storage HPP

The 48th Executive Committee meeting of IEA Hydro TCP will be organized in Klagenfurt, Austria, in April 2026. The meeting will be organized along with individual Task Workshops on Tuesday, April 21 (Task meetings), Wednesday, April 22 (ExCo meeting) and Thursday, April 23 (site visit).

Thursday, April 23: Field trip to Malta-Reisseck storage/pumped storage hydropower complex, about 100 km from Klagenfurt. Malta-Reisseck is one of the largest pumped-storage HPP schemes in Austria with several dams and reservoirs, power stations and pumping stations. Due to snow conditions only the main power station will be accessible. Continuation to the run-of-river HPP Feistritz-Ludmannsdorf on the Drau River (20 km from Klagenfurt) with one of the highest and most innovative fish ladders in Europe with permanent AI supported fish monitoring. Return to Klagenfurt early in the evening (Trains to Vienna main station can be reached).
